1. Reading Challenge (5 Days a Week)

2. Creative Writing (Choose any 2 topics)

- Short Story (150–200 words):

3. Grammar Practice

- Tenses – Frame or rewrite 10 sentences
- Active and Passive Voice – Convert or write 10 sentences

- Prepositions and Conjunctions – Fill in the blanks

4. Vocabulary Builder: Personal Dictionary

- Write 1 new word every day (minimum 20 words)
- For each word:
 - Write the meaning
 - Use it in a sentence
 - Add a synonym

5. Fun Project (Choose any 1)

- Comic Strip with 8–10 boxes, including dialogues and pictures
- Mini Book of 5 short moral stories with illustrations
